

Uniform and Appearance Policy

1. Purpose:

At The Reach Free School, a high standard of personal appearance is expected of, and from, all pupils. Our uniform identifies us as our own community and makes us recognisable in the wider community. As such, it is imperative that it is worn with pride and in accordance with this policy.

2. Principles:

This policy aims support the ethos and school to:

- Foster the community ethos of the school;
- Encourage a sense of equality and cohesion;
- Protect pupils from social pressures to dress in a particular way;
- Ensure that pupils of different social, religious and ethnic groups feel welcome;
- Support achievement and teaching and learning;
- Provide a safe and secure environment in which pupils learn how to dress appropriately.

3. Uniform Items:

3.1 Boys:

The Reach Free School blazer*

The Reach Free School jumper*

The Reach Free School tie*, worn to cover all buttons on shirt

White formal shirt, worn with all buttons done up and tucked in (long or short sleeved, no coloured or patterned roll necks or T-shirts underneath permitted)

Suit style black trousers (no denim, joggers or 'skinnies' permitted)

Plain black formal leather, flat, black shoes (no boots or trainers permitted)

Black/dark grey socks

3.2 Girls:

The Reach Free School blazer*

The Reach Free School jumper*

White reverse collar blouse, worn with all buttons done up and tucked in (long or short sleeved, no coloured or patterned roll necks or T-shirts underneath permitted)

Suit style black trousers (no denim, joggers, leggings or 'skinnies' permitted)

OR

Black formal skirt, worn no higher than the middle of the knee

Plain black formal leather, flat, black shoes (no boots or trainers permitted)

Plain black or plain dark grey tights

Black or dark grey socks

*These items are only available from The Reach Free School

3.3 Blazers

Blazers must be worn at all times indoors and may only be removed with the permission of the class teacher.

3.4 Outerwear

A smart black or grey plain coat or jacket may be worn to and from school. Woollen hats and scarves may be worn in cold weather but extreme styles will not be permitted, this includes football motifs or brand logos. Outerwear must not be worn indoors at any time.

3.5 Make-up

Make up is not permitted in years 7 or 8 . In year 9 and beyond, subtle* make-up may be worn.

The following items are never permitted:

- Nail varnish
- Nail extensions, acrylic or gel
- False eyelashes

* 'Subtle' is taken to mean a thin layer of foundation, no bright colours or excessive application of cosmetic products. Pupils will be required to remove any make-up which does not fit this description.

3.6 Jewellery

Pupils may wear a wristwatch and one pair of stud earrings. No other jewellery is permitted.

3.7 Hair

Hair must be kept tidy, no extreme lengths or styles are permitted.

Minimum length: Grade 2

Other styling: Parents, Guardians and Carers must ensure that their child avoids unconventional hairstyles or colours. The Reach Free School reserves the right to insist on re-styling if it considers the style inappropriate.

Shaved patterns in hair or eyebrows are not permitted.

4. Exceptions

The Headteacher may grant exceptions to any of the above, but only where this is required for sincere religious or cultural reasons and where this can be substantiated by a letter from the leader of the relevant community.

Pupils' uniform must be in keeping with the school's ethos. Extremes of fashion will not be permitted. Pupils that come to school in clothing that the Headteacher or Deputy Headteachers consider to be unacceptable will be either internally secluded or sent home to change.

5.3 Additional Items Required

Shin pads are required for Hockey and Football.

The school strongly recommends the wearing of a custom-fit mouth guard for sports such as Hockey and Rugby.

5.4 Team Kit

Pupils that are selected to represent The Reach Free School at sports fixtures will have the opportunity to wear team kit. Pupils that do not have the appropriate team kit when they are selected for a team will be able to use a team kit from the PE store.
