



### Residential Educational Visits Proposal - September 2019

Year Group	Term (Month)	Duration	Destination	Subject(s)	Estimated Cost	Rationale
7	Spring/ Summer (March/ April)	1 week	Mallorca	Languages	£350 - £400	The majority of pupils begin learning Spanish when they join the school and it is an expectation for them to continue learning the subject all the way through to GCSE and beyond. Therefore, a residential visit early on brings tangible learning experiences for our pupils to draw on in their lessons.
8	Summer (June/ July)	1 week	France	PE	£400 - £500	Activity weeks are an important part of education as they provide opportunities for our pupils to try out unique sports, which are not accessible on the curriculum. They also help to develop key social skills and independence, particularly as pupils are beginning to become young adults.
9	Spring (January/ February)	3 days	France	Humanities	£200 - £250	A large portion of the year 9 Humanities curriculum focuses on the World Wars of the 20 <sup>th</sup> Century. This experience brings that learning to life and gives our pupils a chance to visit the battlefields and begin to understand the scale of the sacrifices people took.
9/10	Spring/ Summer (March)	1 week	Spain	Languages	£300 - £500	This visit will allow pupils to develop their understanding of the subject and immerse themselves in the Spanish language and culture. Pupils will attend Spanish lessons, flamenco and local gastronomy workshops and take part in cultural visits.
10	Spring (March)	1 week	France	Enterprise	£300	The visit will allow pupils to explore the theory they learn in their Business lessons and apply it to real life application at Disneyland Paris through a range of activities and workshops run by Disney. They will have seminars from a range of top business people who have been brought in specifically for the event.

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10	Spring/Summer (March/ May)	2 days each time	UK	Duke of Edinburgh Bronze	£30	As part of the Duke of Edinburgh Bronze Award, pupils will take part in expeditions at local Scout campsites (Phasels Wood and Braid Wood). Some equipment will be provided by the school and parents will only be expected to purchase minimal equipment.
Any	Spring (February Half Term)	1 week	Europe	PE (Skiing)	£700 - £900	A skiing trip can be either a once in a lifetime experience or the beginning of a hobby, which develops over many years. A skiing trip, in or around February half term, is in the long term plans for the school and naturally due to the cost involved we would give parents, guardians and carers a significant amount of notice for this trip.
12	Spring/Summer (April/ May)	4 days each time	UK	Duke of Edinburgh Gold	£50	As part of the Duke of Edinburgh Gold Award, pupils will take part in expeditions in the Brecon Beacons and Snowdonia. Some equipment will be provided by the school and parents will only be expected to purchase minimal equipment.
12/13	TBC	TBC	Europe (Barcelona or Madrid)	A Level subjects including Spanish, History and Geography	£300 - £500	This is an opportunity for our A Level curriculum to include educational visits which enhance the option choices of pupils. Teachers will be able to plan part of their A Level curriculum around the educational visit and for pupils to experience their option choice first hand. This will include experiencing rich history, a different culture as well as bringing their chosen pathway to life.
12	Spring	4 days	UK	Geography	£200	As part of the A level Geography course pupils must complete 4 days of fieldwork covering both Human and Physical aspects. The fieldwork is designed to introduce a range of skills required for success in their Non Examined Assessment which is 20% of their final grade. The trip also embeds abstract concepts with real life examples and equipment that cannot be accessed in the normal classroom environment.
